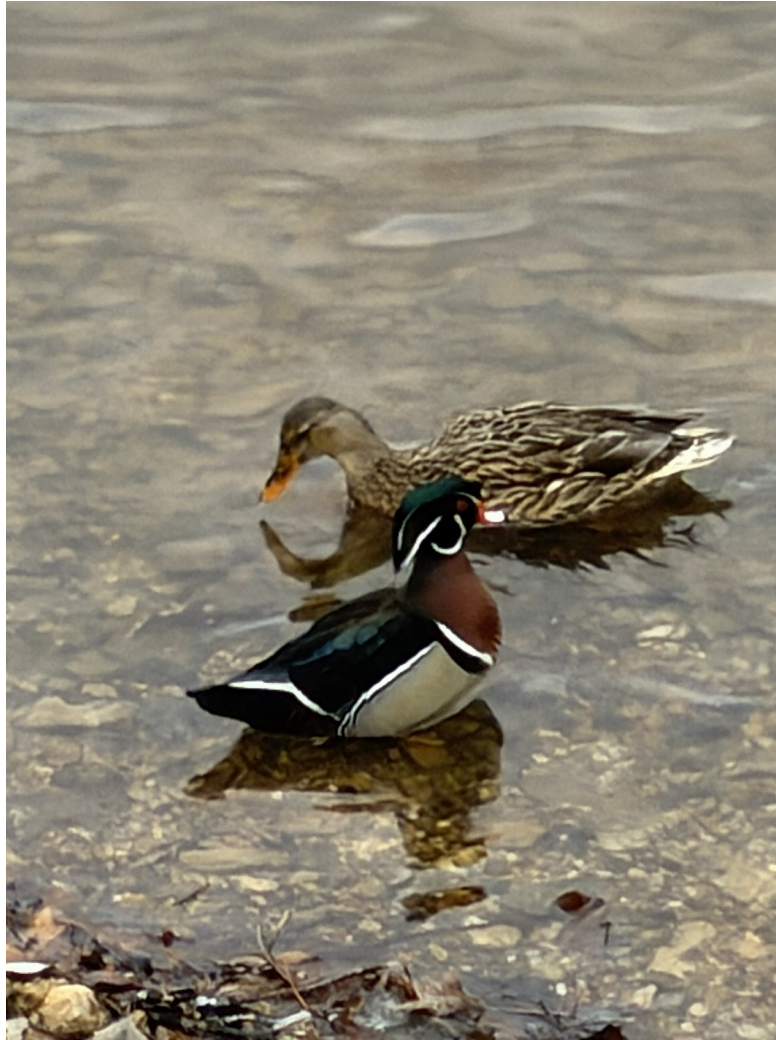
Member Contribution – SuZanne Axt
